This also applies to the firm/company for its allied/ sister firms and units. The concern/company/firm which stands blacklisted /banned either by Tender Inviting Authority or Govt. Of Rajasthan or by any other State/Central Government on the date of bid submission shall not be eligible to participate in the tender.

- (xiv) Original Tender Catalogue **Annexure-C** duly filled. (Bidder should mark in the specific column, whether complied the specification or not)
- (xv) The firm/bidders should submit the list of plant and machinery, staff, factory area, etc. on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 50/- (Notarized) in enclosed Performa (Annexure-H).

NOTE: -

- (A) All above mentioned documents duly notarized/attested by Notary public must be submitted. Un attested/ Un-notarized copies of such document will not be considered valid.
- (B) All attested document must be submitted in Hindi or English language. If the documents are not in Hindi or English, they should be translated in Hindi or English & attested by authorized translator. Translated copy along with copy of original document must be submitted.
- (C) Other than Sales tax clearance certificate, all above mention documents should be under the name & address of premises where the quoted items are actually manufactured.
- (D) The point of supply within the state of Rajasthan or out of Rajasthan should be specified under condition no. 4 (xi)(b).
- (E) TENDER WILL BE LIABLE FOR OUTRIGHT REJECTION IF:-
 - (I) ANY RATES ARE DISCLOSED IN COVER A.
 - (II) ANY DISCOUNTS/ SPECIAL OFFERS ARE MADE IN COVER A.
- (F) The Bidder may submit Profit & Loss account & Balance Sheet and annual turnover statement of the previous 3 (three) financial years.
- (G) If the following item/certificate not submitted, the tender will not be considered responsive:-
 - (i) Tender Fees and processing fee for RISL
 - (ii) EMD.
 - (iii) Manufacturing License/Acknowledgment of Manufacturing License/EM-II from industry department/DIC/NSIC/ Competent Authority.
 - (iv) Import License along with authorization from foreign principals, if applicable.
 - (v) Turnover Certificate.
 - (vi) BIS Certificate/License in case of ISI marked items, if applicable.
- 5. Financial Bid duly filled as per Annexure-"D" giving the rates for Quoted items should be submitted.

NOTE :-

- (A) If any item in catalogue has different sizes, lengths, strength & sub group etc., Rates of each size, length, strength and sub-group must be filled in separate format (Annexure "D").
- (B) **VAT or CST** should **be** mentioned clearly & Separately.
- (C) If the VAT or CST is exempted it should be specified in Annexure 'D'.
- (D) The bidder who has quoted excise "NIL" in PRICE Schedule and item becomes excisable afterwards at the time of award of contract or later on, firm will be eligible for payment only on production of invoices drawn as per Central Excise Rules.
- 6. Both Technical & Financial should be submitted to the M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd., D-Block, Swasthya Bhawan, C-scheme, Jaipur-302005 within prescribed time & date. All received tenders will be opened in the presence of Bidder who chooses to be present. Financial will be opened only for those Bidders who satisfy the standard criteria laid down by the department on the details furnished by the Bidder in Technical bid, in compliance of Tender terms & conditions.
- 7. (i) In event of Tender being submitted by proprietary firm tender must be signed by sole proprietor. In event of a partnership firm tender must be signed on its behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so; and in the case of company, the tender must be signed by authorized signatory as the manner laid in the Articles of association.
 - (ii) Any change in the Constitution of the Firm/ Company shall be notified forthwith by the contractor in writing to the M.D., RMSC Ltd., Jaipur and such change shall not relieve any former member of the Firm/ Company from the liability under the contract. No new partner / partners shall be accepted in the Firm by the contractor in respect of the contract unless he/ they agree to abide by all its terms and conditions and submit with the M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd., D-Block, Swasthya Bhawan, C-scheme, Jaipur a written agreement to this effect. The contractors receipt for acknowledgement or date of any partner subsequently accepted as above shall bind all of them and will be a sufficient discharge for any of the purposes of the contract.
- 8 Tender documents shall be filled with ink or typed. The Bidder shall sign the tender form at each page and at the end in token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the tender.

9. EARNEST MONEY:

- (i) Tender shall be accompanied with an earnest money of Rs.78,00,000 (Rs Seventy Eight Lakhs only) without which tenders will not be considered as valid. The earnest money deposit shall be paid in the form of Demand Draft/Bankers cheque in favour of Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, payable at Jaipur. This should be submitted physically to M.D., RMSCL before the date and time of submission of bid. Earnest Money Deposit in any other form will not be accepted. The tenders submitted without sufficient EMD will be summarily rejected.
- (ii) Refund of earnest money: The earnest money of unsuccessful Bidder shall be refunded soon after finalization of the tender. Bidder has to produce a Pre stamp receipt as per Annexure-I with the tender Document.

(iii) Partial exemption from earnest money:- Firms which are registered as micro and SSI Unit of Rajasthan with Commissioner of Industries Rajasthan, shall furnish the amount of earnest money in respect of items for which they are registered as such subject to their furnishing attested copy of Acknowledgment of EM-II issued by DIC with an affidavit worth Rs. 10 as per annexure-J at the rate 0.5% i.e. Rs. 19,50,000 (Rs. Nineteen Lakh Fifty Thousand only)

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- The central Government and Government of Rajasthan Undertakings need not (iv) furnish any amount of earnest money.
- The earnest money/security deposit lying with the Corporation in respect of other (v) tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contracts being completed will not be adjusted towards earnest money for the fresh tenders. The earnest money may, however, be taken into consideration in case tenders are re-invited for the same item.

FORFEITURE OF EARNEST MONEY: -10.

The earnest money will be forfeited in the following cases:

- When Bidder withdraws or modifies the offer after opening of tender but before (i) acceptance of tender.
- When Bidder does no execute the agreement, if any, prescribed within the specified (ii) time or extended time by competent authority on the request of the Bidder.
- (iii) When the Bidder does not deposit the security money after the supply order is given.
- (iv) When he fails to commence the supply of the items as per supply order within the time prescribed.
- When he fails to submit samples of quoted item on demand or extended time by (v) competent authority on the request of the Bidder.
- When Bidder violates any terms & conditions of the tender document. (vi)

11. **PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT :-**

- Indigenous products offered for supply by the manufacturer will get preferential (i) treatment in the matter of approval subject to quality standards.
- ISI marked items will be preferred, if applicable. (ii)
- It may be noted that the corporation does not undertake to assist in the procurement (iii) of raw material whether imported or controlled as well as restricted and as such the Bidder must offer their rate to supply the specific items from own quota of stock by visualizing the prospect of availability of raw material needed. Any of the above points if taken, as argument for non-supply/delayed supply will not be entertained.

12. **GUARANTEE CLAUSE:-**

The tenderer would give 3 years comprehensive guarantee that the AMBULANCES (i) would continue to conform to the description and quality as specified for a period of three years or 3 lac kilometer which ever is later on complete AMBULANCES including engine, Gear box, Medical equipment/ all assemblies and other equipments from the date of delivery of the said AMBULANCES to be purchased and that not with standing the fact that the purchaser may have inspected and/or approved the said AMBULANCES if during the period of 3 years, the said AMBULANCES be discovered not to conform to the description and quality as afore said/ or have determined and the decision of the purchase officer in that behalf will be final and conclusive the purchaser will be entitle to reject the said AMBULANCES or such portion there of as may be discovered not to conform to the said description and quality, on such rejection the AMBULANCES will be at the sellers risk and all the provisions relating to rejection of goods, etc., Shall apply. The tenderer shall, if so called upon to do so

replace the goods, etc. or such portion there of as is rejected by the Purchase Officer, otherwise, the tenderer shall pay such damage as may arise by reason of such breach of the condition here in contained. Nothing here in contained shall prejudice any other right of the Purchase Officer in that behalf under this contract or otherwise.

- (ii) In case of machinery and equipment also guarantee will be given as mentioned in above the Tenderer shall during the guarantee period replace parts if any and remove the manufacturing defect if found during the above period so as to make the machinery and equipment operative. The Tenderer shall also replace machinery and equipment in case it is found defective which can not be put to operation due to manufacturing defect etc.
- (iii) In case of machinery and equipment specified by the Purchase Officer the Tenderer shall be responsible for carrying out annual maintenance and repairs on the terms & conditions as may be agreed. The Tenderer shall also be responsible to ensure adequate regular supply of spare parts needed for a specific type of machinery and the equipments whether under their annual maintenance and repairs contract or otherwise. In case of change of model he will give sufficient notice to the Purchase Officer who may like to Purchase spare parts from them to maintain the machinery and equipment in perfect condition.
- (iii) Deleted

(iv) 13. MARKING

All non consumable articles (except glass or imported articles) like instruments, equipments and others accessories etc. should bear "GOVERNMENT OF RAJASTHAN" or as mentioned in supply order in English on each without which the supply will not be entertained.

In case, any item supplied by the approved firm does not conform to the required standard, the payment there of, if received by the supplier shall have to be refunded to the indenting officer/ M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd., Jaipur. The supplier will not have any rightful claim to the payment of cost for substandard supplies which are consumed either in part or whole pending receipt of laboratory test. It may be noted that supply of goods less in weight and volume than those mentioned on the label of the container is an offence and the same will be dealt with in the manner prescribed under rules.

14. RATES AND COMPARISON OF RATES:

Only net rates should be quoted. No Separate free goods or cash discounts should be offered. Rate must be valid for the entire period of the tender and must be offered conforming to the following: -

- (i) (a) Comparison of Rates: In comparing the rates tendered by firm outside Rajasthan and those in Rajasthan but not entitled to Price Preference under the Rules, the element of Rajasthan VAT or CST shall be excluded whereas that of Central Sales Tax shall be included.
 - (b) While comparing the rates in respect of firms within Rajasthan, the element of Rajasthan VAT or CST shall be included.
- (ii) Delivery should be given as Directed by M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd., Jaipur. Situated at different place in Rajasthan and rate must be quoted accordingly, The department will pay no cartage or transportation charges.

- Rates must be offered net only against the specified packing of the items. The net rate must be inclusive of all charges by way of packing, forwarding, incidental or transit charge including transit insurance and any other levies or duties etc. charge on the product except *VAT or CST*. If rates are quoted giving any free goods quantity or cash discounts the same shall not be considered.
- (iv) Only *VAT or CST* and surcharge if applicable will be paid over net rate.
- (v) Excise duty or surcharge prevailing on the date of submission of the rate must be included in the net rate and should also be shown separately in col. 8 of the Financial Bid (Annexure- D). In the event of any subsequent variation (increase or decrease) in excise duty and VAT or CST by the government (State or central) the same will be modified accordingly.
- (vi) Other statutory increase or decrease shall be agreed upon mutually between Corporation and contractor and revised rate shall be applicable to order received by the contractor on or subsequent to the date of such increase/decrease in government duty.
- (vii) The rates should be confined as far as possible to the packing units mentioned in the catalogue and different rate for different packing should be avoided. In no case the rate should be split up showing the cost of any on the component parts of the specified item. If split price are found, the item may be treated as rejected. If the prices of item found same from two for more bidders then the equivalent bidders shall be asked to submit their financial bid again with reduced prices within given time by RMSC.
- (viii) The rates must be written both in words and figures. In case of discrepancy between the prices quoted in words and in figures, lower of the two shall be considered. There should not be errors or overwriting and corrections, if any, should be made clearly and initialed with dates. Element of the Rajasthan VAT or CST or Central Sales Tax should be mentioned separately.
- (xi) The Bidder will exercise all due diligence at their own level regarding applicability of taxes, duties and fees etc. for the unit of supplies as specified in the tender and accordingly include in their quote. Any additional/extra claims over and above the rates agreed pertaining to taxes, duties and fees etc. will not be entertained on account of whatever reasons may be.
- (x) (A) No paper should be detached from the tender form.
 (B) The Bidder shall sign with seal on every page of the tender form and Terms & Conditions (Annexure-B & N) in token of his acceptance of all the Terms & Conditions of the tender and return the same along with tender. He should also sign at the bottom of each page of the original tender catalogue, Non receipt of terms and conditions duly signed with the tender shall render the tender to be rejected.
- (xi) Any change or insertion of any other condition or stipulation in the above terms of supplies are not allowed and if so found, shall render the tender to the rejection without notice.
- **NOTE :-** Specification in Financial Bid (**Annexure-D**) should not be differ from the original tender catalogue specification, otherwise tender may liable to be rejected.

15. APPLICABILITY OF TAXES:

Only one kind of the sales tax will be payable whether Rajasthan *VAT or CST* or Central Sales Tax depending on the relative station of supply as the case may be.

16. SUBMISSION AND RETURN OF SAMPLES & DEMONSTRATIONS:

- (i) Samples must be sent of all the quoted items free of cost within 7 days of last date of bid submission even though the specifications or descriptions etc. are mentioned in the tender form. No sample will be accepted after prescribed period. In the event of non submission of samples within the prescribed period on demand, the tender shall not be considered and Earnest Money shall be forfeited. However, departmental authority may grant extension of time for submission of samples on the request of Bidder.
- (ii) Samples of equipments & instrument of the unsuccessful Bidder may be collected back from the E.D. (EPM), RMSC, Jaipur within the period intimated by him. The corporation will not be responsible for any damage, wear and tear of loss during the course of testing examination etc. The corporation for a period of one month would retain sample of approved items after the expiry of contract. The corporation shall not be responsible for any damage, wear & tear or loss in stipulated period. The corporation will not make any arrangement for return of samples even if the Bidder agrees to pay the cost of transportation. The uncollected samples shall stand forfeited to the corporation after the period allowed for collection and no claim for cost etc. shall be entertained.
- (iii) The tender may be asked to demonstrate the technique, procedure and utility of equipment as per specification of tender document before the technical committee of corporation at store of corporation.
- (iv) Samples should be strictly according to the item quoted in the tender form failing which these will not be considered. Such sample must be delivered free of charge to the E.D. (EPM), RMSC, Jaipur. Sample must be submitted duly sealed and marked suitably either by writing on the sample or on a slip or durable paper securely fastened to the sample with the particulars as mentioned below:-

(A) Name and full address of the firm.

(B) Catalogue No. and name of item.

(C) Name of section.

(D) Name of manufacturer

(E) Brand

 (v) No change in marking on samples will be allowed after the submission of the sample. Samples should be submitted along with separate challan in triplicate. Samples without challan will not be accepted.

17. SECURITY DEPOSIT & AGREEMENT:

(i) All firms whose offers are accepted will have to deposit a security equal to five per cent (5%) of the total value of approximate quantity as per tender catalogue in favour of M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd., Jaipur at the time of agreement. The security amount shall in no case be less than the earnest money.

- (ii) The S.D. shall be 5% of the total value of stores. If the total value of stores supplied by the firm to various purchase officers of the Department excluding medical education department (as clause-22) is exceeds to total value of approximate quantity as NIT, the firm shall deposit an additional 5% security of value of supply orders to M.D. RMSC. Before ensuring the security deposit, the Purchase Officer will not release payment until the additional S.D. amount deposited by the suppliers. Additional S.D. shall be estimated/calculated based on the information submitted by firms in statement no. "I" and "II".
- (iii) The earnest money of successful Bidder will be adjusted toward security deposit and balance will be given in the form of Demand Draft/ Bankers cheque favouring Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, payable at Jaipur.
- (iv) The purchase committee of corporation or at the level of Board of Directors, RMSC may permit the firm to submit Bank Guarantee issued by any nationalized bank (the validity of bank guarantee should be up to 6 months after completion of guarantee period) also for the part (up to 50%) or full amount (where the amount exceeds Rs. 10.00 Lacs) in lieu of demand draft/Bankers cheque in appropriate cases towards security deposit.
- (v) The security will be refunded after six months from the date of expiry of the contract on satisfactory completion of contract and after satisfying that there are no dues outstanding against the Bidder.
- (vi) Firms which are registered as micro and SSI units with the Department of Industries, Rajasthan shall furnish the amount of security deposit @1% of total value of approximate quantity as per tender catalogue on furnishing attested copy of Acknowledgment of EM-II issued by DIC with an affidavit as per annexure-I. Provision of 17 (ii) also applies.
- (vii) It is to be noted that earlier years earnest money/security deposit, even if lying in this department, shall not be considered towards this contract and therefore fresh security deposit should be furnished.
- (viii) The supply orders shall only be placed after deposition of appropriate amount of S.D. and its adjustment orders by the Corporation.
- (ix) The department will pay no interest on security deposit/Earnest money deposit.
- (x) Successful Bidders will have to execute an agreement on a Non Judicial Stamp Paper Rs. (As mention in Offer letter) in the prescribed form with the M.D./ E.D.(EPM), Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, Jaipur and deposit security for the performance of the contract within **15 days** from the date on which the acceptance of the tender, under Registered post, is communicated to him. However, M.D. RMSC Ltd., Jaipur may condone the delay in execution of contract by the Bidder. The expenses of completing and stamping the agreement shall be paid by the Bidder and the department shall be furnished free of charge with one executed stamped counter part of the agreement. The validity of rate contract under this agreement shall be for a period of one year from the last day of the month of agreement execution.
- (xi) The Bidder shall furnish the following documents at the time of execution of agreement:-
 - (i) Attested copy of Partnership Deed in case of Partnership Firms.
 - (ii) Registration Number and year of registration in case partnership firm is registered with Registrar of Firms.

- (iii) Address of residence and office, telephone numbers in case of Sole Proprietorship.
- (iv) Registration issued by Registrar of Companies in case of Company.
- (v) Comprehensive maintenance agreement, if applicable.
- (xii) The M.D., RMSC Ltd., Rajasthan, Jaipur can extend the original rate contract, subject to original Terms and Conditions for a period deemed fit by him, but not exceeding six months, for which the Bidder will have to abide. However the extension beyond six months can be granted on mutual consent but not beyond one year.
- (xiii) In case of breach of any terms and conditions of the contract or on unsatisfactory performance, the amount of security deposit shall be liable to forfeiture in full or part by M.D. RMSC Ltd., Jaipur and decision of M.D. RMSC Ltd., Jaipur shall be final.
- (xiv) Central and Rajasthan State Government Undertakings need not furnish amount of Security Deposit.
- (xv) The 25% of total deposited S.D. amount shall be withheld against the security of supplementary (CMA) agreement. If there is any default in comprehensive maintenance service the department may forfeit the penalty amount described under different clauses or any other recovery from this security deposit.
- (xvi) The contract for the supply can be repudiated at any time by the M.D., RMSC Ltd., Rajasthan, Jaipur if the supplies are not made to his satisfaction after giving an opportunity to the Bidder of being heard and after reasons for repudiation being recorded by him in writing. However, M.D., RMSC may terminate agreement of rate contract at any time without notice/intimation to Bidder/ firm/company in public interest.

18. SUPPLY ORDERS:

- (i) (a) The supply orders will be placed to the approved manufacturer only (not agents/Suppliers/Distributors etc.) by MD, RMSC, through registered post only. The date of registration at the post office will be treated as the date of purchase order for calculating the period of supply. The supply period shall be 90 days for the first supply order as per supply schedule at (ii) below, from the date of purchase order including for preparation of prototype/sample and its approval
 - (b)**Termination for default:** The right to cancel the supply order rests only with the MD RMSC.
- (ii) Supply schedule shall be as follows:-

First 30 Days	31-60 Days	61 to 90 Days	And so on
prototype/sample and its approval	100 Vehicles	126 Vehicles	60 Vehicles per 30 days

In case of break in supply order, the supply of 60 vehicles shall be ensured within 45 days from date of issuance of supply order during currency of R.C

(iii) The supply commitment as per Annexure-E may be considered for placement of supply orders to firm. The ready stock position of material, if provided by the firm may also be considered by the department for the placement of supply orders in addition to commitments, taking also in view the requirement of department. Firm may submit ready stock position by the 10th of each month to the department.

- (iii) The quantity indicated in the catalogues are mere estimates and are intended to give an idea to the prospective Tenderer to enable them to decide whether they will undertake to supply the article to this Department on most competitive rates. The figures indicated in the catalogue do not constitute any commitment on the part of department to purchase any of the articles in the quantities shown therein against each or in any quantity whatsoever. It is further made clear that the Department does not bind itself to purchase all or any quantity mentioned in the catalogue and no objection against the quantity of the indent of approved item being more or less than the approximate quantity will be entertained and shall not be acceptable as a ground for non supply on the quantity indented.
- (iv) Price Preference: Price preference/ purchase preference will be given to the goods produced or manufactured by industries of Rajasthan over goods produced or manufactured by Industries out side Rajasthan as per Purchase of Stores (Preference to Industries of Rajasthan) Rules, 1995. It is clarified that purchase preference only be granted to the industries of Rajasthan.
- (v) (a) Comparison of Rates: In comparing the rates tendered by firm outside Rajasthan and those in Rajasthan but not entitled to Price Preference under the Rules, the element of Rajasthan VAT or CST shall be excluded whereas that of Central Sales Tax shall be included.

(b) While comparing the rates in respect of firms within Rajasthan, the element of Rajasthan VAT or CST shall be included.

19. SUBMISSION OF RETURN AND CONTRACT COMPLETION REPORT:-

(a) Submission of Return:

The firm shall furnish consolidated statement (**Annexure-K**) of supplies made, in enclosed formats to each consignee (S) in statement No.1 and to ED EPM, RMSCL by 10th of each month duly verified by the consignee(s). Every time the statement should contain details of all orders placed under the contract. Please note that if statements are not submitted in time then the payments may be withheld and the firms shall be responsible for such delay in payments. Firms will have to submit consolidated statement No.II in duplicate at the end of R/C as well as after expiry of material guarantee period (as provided in guarantee clause of the contract) to enable the Corporation to examine the case for refund of security money. The consignee will submit every month verified copy of statement No.1 (**Annexure-K-I**) along with his comment to ED EPM, RMSCL for monitoring of receipt of supplies.

(b) Submission Of Contract Completion Report: -

- The consignee should submit the consolidated contract completion report in the prescribed statement no. II (Annexure-K-II) against each order to the ED (EPM), RMSC within 30 days of supply/ receipt of material.
- (ii) The consignee shall maintain a register for item supplied to him and will monitor receipt of material, complaints (if any) of defective material, quantity received quality/performance and submission of completion report to ED EPM, RMSCL within one months of receipt of material.
- (iii) It shall be the responsibility of the consignee to get registered the complaint of defective material or defective performance immediately in the office of ED (EPM), RMSCL/MD, RMSCL for taking action against the contractor/supplier. Intimation to the contractor/supplier shall also be sent by the consignee immediately just after noticing such defects in material/performance in such a manner, so as to reach in the office of the firm immediately and before completion of guarantee period. Any delay in taking action shall be viewed seriously by the corporation.

20. TERMS OF PAYMENT :- As per special condition no. 18

21. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

- (i) The time specified for delivery in the tender form shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the successful Bidder shall arrange supplies within the period on receipt of order from the Purchasing Officers.
- (ii) In case of extension in the delivery period with liquidated damages the recovery shall be made on the basis of following percentages of value of Stores which the Bidder has failed to supply :-
 - (a) Delay up to one- fourth period of the prescribed Delivery Period 2.5%
 - (b) Delay exceeding one fourth but not exceeding half of the prescribed delivery period - 5%
 - (c) Delay exceeding half but not exceeding three- fourth of the prescribed delivery period 7.5%
 - (d) Delay exceeding three- fourth of the prescribed period -10%
- (iii) Fraction of a day in reckoning the period of delay in supplies shall be eliminated if it is less than half a day.
- (iv) The maximum amount of agreed liquidated damage shall be 10%.
- (v) If the supplier requires an extension of time in completion of contractual supply on account of occurrence of any hindrance, he shall apply in writing to M.D. RMSC Ltd., Jaipur, which has placed the supply order, for the same immediately on occurrence of the hindrance but not after the stipulated date of completion of supply. The firms shall ensure extension of delivery period for delayed supplies. The payment shall only released by purchase officer after sanction of extension in delivery period by M.D., RMSC.
- (vi) Delivery period may be extended with or without liquidated damages. If the delay in the supply of goods is on account of hindrances beyond the control of the Bidder, the extension in delivery period may be granted without Liquidated Damage.
- (vi) If the Bidder is unable to complete the supply within the specified or extended period, the purchasing officer shall be entitled to purchase the goods or any part thereof from elsewhere without notice to the Bidder on his (i.e., Bidders) account and risk only with the prior approved from M.D., RMSC Ltd., Jaipur. The Bidder shall be liable to pay any loss or damage which the purchasing officer may sustain by reasons of such failure on the part of the Bidder.

The Bidder shall not be entitled to any gain on such purchases made against default. The recovery of such loss or damage shall be made from any sums accruing to the Bidder under this or any other contract with the government. If recovery is not possible from the bill and the Bidder fails to pay the loss or damage, within one month of the demand, the recovery of such amount or sum due from the Bidder shall be made under the Rajasthan Public Demand Recovery Act 1952 or any other law for the time being in force. In case more than one supplier has been approved for any item under the approved list circulated to the purchasing officers, the risk purchases may be made at a higher rate from any other firm whose rate is duly approved. It is mandatory for the approved supplier to acknowledge receipt of orders with in fifteen days from the date of dispatch of order, failing which the purchasing officers will be at liberty to initiate action to purchase the items on risk purchase system at the expiry of the prescribed supply period. 23. **RECOVERIES** :-

- (i) Recoveries of liquidated damages, short supplies, breakage, rejected articles shall ordinary be made from bills. Such amount may also be recovered from any other untied dues & security deposits available with department. In case recovery is not possible, recourse will be taken under Rajasthan PDR Act or any other law in force.

- c) Inspection Committee can however undertake inspection on the basis of an attested copy of supply order provided by the firm, after comparing it with the original ink signed supply order available with the firm.
- d) The Tenderer should ensure that ambulances accepted by the Inspection Committee after inspection have been properly and legibly stamped by latter's identification stamp/Seal.

The samples, all materials, tools, labour, testing equipment and assistance which the Inspection Committee may demand of him to verify the conformity of the ambulances to the quality requirement etc. will be provided without any extra charge.
- Inspection by a committee with regard manufacturing capacity & availability of infrastructure prior to acceptance offer may be undertaken by the department, In case of any deviation is found in tender submission and conclusion of by inspection committee aforesaid, the offer of the tenderer may not be considered

25. PACKING & INSURANCE:

e)

- (i) The good will be delivered at the destination in perfect condition. The firm if so desires may insure valuable goods against loss by theft, destruction or damages by fire, flood, under exposure to weather of otherwise in any situation. The insurance charges will have to be borne by the supplier and the department shall not be required to pay any such charges, if incurred.
- (ii) The firm shall be responsible for the proper packing so as to avoid damages under normal conditions of transport by Sea, Rail, Road or Air and delivery of material in good condition to the Purchase Officer's store. In the event of any loss, damage, breakage or leakage or any shortage the firm shall be liable to make good such loss and shortage found at destination after the Checking/inspection of material by the consignee. No extra cost on such account shall be admissible. The firm may keep its agent to verify any damage or loss discovered at the consignee's store, if it so likes.
- (iii) Packing, cases, containers and other allied material if any shall be supplied free, except where otherwise specified by the firm(s) and agreed by the corporation and the same shall not be returned to him.

26. **REJECTION:**

(i) Articles not as per specification/ or not approved shall be rejected by the Corporation and will have to be replaced by the supplier firm at its own cost within the time limit fixed by the corporation.

- (ii) All the stores supplied shall be of the best quality and conforming to the specification, trademark laid down in the schedule attached to agreement and in strict accordance with and equal to the approved, standard, samples. In case of any material of which there are no standards or approved samples, the supply shall be of the best quality to be substantiated by documents. The decision of M.D., RMSC Ltd., Jaipur as to the quality of stores be final and binding upon the Bidder. In case any of the article supplied are not found as per specification or declared substandard/spurious, they shall be liable to be rejected and any expenses of loss caused to the supplier as a result of rejection of supplies shall be entirely at his account.
- (iii) If, however, due to exigencies of Government work/interest such replacement either in whole or in part is not considered feasible, the prices of such articles will be reduced suitably. In cases where material has been used & some defect are noticed then the firm can be allowed to rectify/replace defects in portion of such defective material. The prices fixed by M.D., RMSC Ltd., Rajasthan Jaipur shall be final.
- (iv) The rejected materials must be removed by the firm, within 15 days of the date of intimation of rejection. The officials concerned will take reasonable care of such material but in no case shall be responsible for any loss, damage, shortage that may occur while it is in their premises.
- (v) No payment shall be made for defective materials. However, if payment has been made, then defective material shall be allowed to be removed only after the firm replaces material as per specifications, duly inspected. If the payment has not been made, the firm may be allowed to remove the material without prior replacement (provided firm has deposited Security money as per condition no. 20) Joint inspection of defective material may be carried out as required by the corporation. However sample of ISI marked material found defective shall be kept by consignee for reference to BIS.
- (vi) In case firm wants to take back material to their works for rectification then firm has to deposit payment received against such defective supplies. In case supplier firm has not received any payment then material be returned to supplier firm for rectification, if then firm has deposited required security deposit as per contract.
- (vii) The Bidder shall be responsible for the proper packing and delivery of the material to the consignee. In the event of any loss, damage, or breakage, leakage or shortage, the Bidder shall make good the loss and shortage found at the checking of the materials by the consignee. No extra cost on such account shall be admissible.
- 27. PARALLEL RATE CONTRACT :- The corporation may also execute parallel rate contract to with more than one firm for each item on the lowest approved prices on the same terms & conditions, if the original lowest one each not in a position to supply material as per department's requirements.
 - (i.) To ensure sustained supply without any interruption, the Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to fix more than one supplier to supply the requirement among the qualified Bidders.

- (ii.) Orders will be placed with lowest-1 (L-1) firm. However in case of any exigency at the discretion of the Tender Inviting Authority, the orders may also be placed with the other firms, in the ascending order, L-2, L-3 and so on who have matched with the L-1 rates and executed agreement with corporation on same terms & conditions.
- (iii.) After the conclusion of Price Bid opening (cover-B) the lowest offer of the Bidder is considered for negotiations and rate arrived after negotiations is declared as L-1 rate and L-1 supplier for an item for which the tender has been invited.
- (iv.) The tender who has been declared as L-1 supplier for certain item shall execute necessary agreement for the supply of the tendered quantity of such item as specified in the tender documents on depositing the required amount performance security and on execution of the agreement such Bidder is eligible for the placement of purchase orders.
- (v.) RMSC will inform the L-1 rate to the Bidders who had qualified for Price Bid (Cover-B) opening, inviting their consent to match with the L-1 rate for the item/items quoted by them and the Bidders who agree to match L-1 rate, will be considered as Matched L-1.
- (vi.) The Bidder, who agrees to match L-1 rate shall furnish the breakup detail (Rate, CST, VAT etc.) of price (L-1 rate).
- (vii.) The supplier, on receipt of the purchase orders deems that the purchase orders exceeds the production capacity declared in the tender documents and the delay would occur in executing the order, shall inform the RMSC immediately without loss of time and the purchase orders shall be returned within 7 days from the date of issuing order, failing which the supplier would be deprived from disputing the imposition of liquidated damages, and penalty for the delayed supplies.

Subletting or assigning contract to third party is prohibited. In the event of Bidder violating this condition, the M.D., Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation, Jaipur shall be at liberty to place the contract elsewhere on the Bidder's account and at his risk. The Bidder shall be liable for any loss or damage, which the Government may sustain in consequence or arising out of such replacement of the contract.

31. FALL CLAUSE:-

The prices charged for the Store supplies under the contract by successful Bidder shall in no event exceed the lowest price at which the successful Bidder sells the stores of identical description to any other persons during the period of the contract. If any time, during the period of the contract, the Bidder reduces the sales price chargeable under the contract, he shall forth with notify such reduction to the M.D., RMSCL, Jaipur and the price payable under the contract of the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale shall stand correspondingly reduced.

32. COMPREHENSIVE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT (CMA):- Deleted

- **35.** (i) Direct or indirect canvassing on the part of Bidders or their representative shall disqualify their tenders.
 - (ii) Supplier may be disqualified, banned or suspended from business during the rate contract, if :-
 - (a) fails to execute a contract or fails to execute it satisfactorily ;
 - (b) no longer has the technical staff or equipment considered necessary ;
 - (c) is declared bankrupt or insolvent or its financial position has become unsound, and in the case of a limited company, it is wound-up or taken into liquidation;
 - (d) the firm is suspected to be doubtful loyalty to state .
 - (e) the State Bureau of Investigation or any other investigating agency recommends such a course in respect of a case under investigation .
 - (f) M.D., RMSCL, Rajasthan, Jaipur is prima- facie of the view that the firm is guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude in relation to business dealings, which if established would result in business dealing with it banned.
- **36.** No Action on the letter head of the Bidder /firm regarding any complaints against the Corporation will be taken unless the letter head bears the signature of the Bidder or the Authority higher than the bid signatory of the firm.

Any certificate/documents/information submitted by the Bidder found to be (i) false/forged/fabricated etc. than bidder shall be liable for the appropriate legal action along with disgualification, banning, suspension etc. etc. for limited or unlimited period. Bidders are required to submit wanted information (if any) based on the facts. If (ii) the furnished information by the firm found to misleading or not based facts on disciplinary action against the firm may be taken as to banning concerned item/items for certain or uncertain period.
- **38.** The Corporation reserves the right to accept any tender not necessarily the lowest. Corporation may reject any tender without assigning any reasons and accept tender for all or anyone or more of the articles for which Bidder has been given or distribute items of stores to more than one firm/supplier.
- **39.** The Purchase Committee will have the right of rejection of all or any of the quotations without giving any reason for the same. The right to conclude parallel rate contracts with another firm for the stores detailed in this catalogue is also reserved by the M.D., RMSC Ltd., Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- **40.** Extra stipulation or any other condition contrary to the above Tender conditions are not acceptable and may render the tender liable to rejection.
- **41.** The Bidder must sign all the pages of tender document at the below of Terms & Conditions agreeing to abide by all conditions of the tender and accept them in toto.
- **42.** The Purchase Committee of RMSC may recommend change/ modification in terms and conditions in the exigency of the corporation work. In case of such urgency the Terms & Conditions shall be got approved from the Board of Directors of RMSC.
- **43. JURISDICTION:-** All actions, legal proceedings and suits arising from or connected to this tender shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Jaipur only.

Annexure-C

SPECIFICATION OF AMBULANCE

General Vehicular Design and Floor Plans:

This ambulance should be fully built on chasis of a major Indian OE manufacturer of repute. In either case, the vehicle manufacturer should have dealership network and repair servicing facility in major cities of India.

The ambulance should be designed, built and complete with operating accessories as specified herein. The assembly, sub-assembly and equipment should be integrated in such a way so as to enable the vehicle function in a reliable way and in a sustained fashion for durability, safety and comfort.

The design of the vehicle and the specified equipment shall permit accessibility for servicing/replacement and adjustment of components/parts and accessories, with minimum disturbance to other components and systems. Also, the bidder shall ensure that sufficient re-enforcement is provided to protect the components, assemblies, pipelines, tubing, wiring, etc. which are susceptible to damage/hazards encountered during on-road, off-road, cross-country operations of ambulance.

The emergency medical care vehicles, including chassis, ambulance body, equipment, devices, medical accessories and electronic equipment shall be brand new standard commercial products, tested and certified to meet or exceed the requirements of these specifications.

The ambulance should meet the axle load distribution as per Central motor vehicles Rules.

The gross payload applicable herein is maximum 1.5 ton. (This payload is after the ambulance is fully built accommodating all necessary fitments, equipment, tools, etc).

Ambulance should have two compartments i.e driver's cabin and patient compartment. Separated by a partition with a view panel and should not be accessible to dust water with all doors and windows closed.

Overall Dimensions:

The overall length of the ambulance should be 5400 m.m to 5500 m.m excluding rear steps and bumper guard.

The overall width of the ambulance should be 2000 to 2100 m.m.

The finished floor (loading) height shall be such that specified collapsible stretcher may be loaded in ambulance smoothly single handedly with full comfort of patient.

Overhang

The front overhang of the vehicle shall not exceed 40% of the wheelbase (excluding front tow hook). The rear overhang of the vehicle shall not exceed 60% of the wheelbase (excluding rear entry steps and toe hook).

Ground Clearance

Vehicle should have ground clear of 180 mm minimum to 210mm maximum

Diesel Engine and Power Train

The diesel engine should meet BS III requirements of CMVR TAP Document, prevailing in the state of registration of the vehicle as on date of commissioning.

The engine coolants, lubricants, oil etc should be able to perform satisfactorily under atmosphere temperature upto 50° C, and also at prevailing humidity, pressure and weather conditions in state of Rajasthan accessibility to check, maintain and refueling for oil, lubricants etc should be easily accessible and marked/symbolized.

The engine horse power, torque, drive train and transmission and tyres should be such that it should meet the following requirements:

- 1. The vehicles shall be capable of a sustained speed of not less than 75 km/h over dry, hard surfaced, level roads.
- 2. The engine of the vehicle should of minimum 75 HP generation capacity.
- 3. The vehicle should be able to negotiate hilly area gradients and sharp bends.
- 4. Alternator capacity output not less than 90 amp.

Steering & Suspension

Ambulance should be fitted with power assisted steering system, for easy and comfortable steerability of the vehicle at low and high speeds. The vehicle also should comply with the steering requirements, as per CMVR.

Vehicle shall be equipped with laterally matched sets (front and rear) of spring, torsion, or air **suspension system** components suitable to ensure comfortable ride and safety of the patient. The suspension maybe reinforced suitable to provided additional comfort.

Tyres

The tyres fitted on the ambulance should be Radial tyres (with/without tube) of Indian make, and type approved by any of the testing agencies specified in CMVR, 1989 for its load, speed performance and durability and tyres should be two in front and two in rear with spare wheel.

A spare wheel should be housed at appropriate place and indicated.

Brakes

The vehicle should meet all requirements of CMVR. Though it is desirable that the ambulance be equipped with ABS System, fitment of the same is optional.

Fuel Tank (Fuel Storage capacity)

The fuel tank should be approved as a stand-alone component, as per Indian Standard/ CMVR requirement, for all necessary safety aspects and performance.

The capacity of the fuel tank should be such that it should suffice the need 400 km. with one-time filling. The fuel tank should be with fuel fill splash plates.

Cab-Body Provision

Additionally, driver's cabin should be provided with-

- a. Dual sun visors (padded)
- b. Armrests, mounted on each side door.
- c. Key operated ignition/starter switch.
- d. Ammeter and Voltmeter OPTIONAL.
- e. Fuel Gauge (s).
- f. Oil pressure gauge- OPTIONAL.
- g. Engine temperature gauge.
- h. Speedometer with odometer.
- i. Environmental controls (air conditioning etc).
- j. Seatbelt and shoulder harness for driver and passenger.
- k. Duel outside mirrors.
- 1. Cab lighting and controls.
- m. Electric horn (s).
- n. Throttle control- OPTIONAL.
- o. Rear Door open indicator.

Body Structure

Ambulances built on OEM Chassis, the ambulance should be fabricated at an IS 16949:2002 or equivalent certified facility.

Combination of 10/12/14G pressed section & 16 gauge MS square galvanized tube structure with apoxy (primer coating) for anti-corrosion, rolled "C" channels for the floor cross members with pressed section for the roof & floor longitudinal.

Body cross member shall be welded with long members using gusset and shall be designed to support the Ambulance body rigidly and withstand tensional loads. Complete structure welding with CO2 process(mig welding).

Drip rail(s) shall be provided around the entire body and have drain points at each corner.

The ambulance should have tow hook as per CMVR.

Branding/ Stickering

The supplier of the vehicle shall provide the branding/ stickering as per approved design provided by NRHM. The design will bear the 108-ambulance ensign (approximately 30sq. ft) and IEC material printed on vinyl film of good quality

Patient Compartment

The patient compartment shall have the provisions for housing:

- a roll-in self-foldable/collapsible stretcher for the patient
- a folding/scoop stretcher
- a squad bench to accommodate minimum four sitting patients or the above mentioned folding/scoop stretcher
- a washbasin with foot operated tap
- Medical Equipment as specified
- Various drugs and consumables
- Other Equipment as specified

Patient compartment volumetric space shall be sufficient in size to transport occupants and accommodate / store all stretchers, squad / cots and litters.

The **length** of the patient compartment measured from partition to the inside edge of the rear loading door at the floor level shall be at least 3350mm ± 15 mm.

The width of the compartment after installation of cabinets shall provide 460 ± 10 mm clear aisle walkway between stretcher / cot and the base of squad bench, with the cot located in the street side (non-centred) position.

The patient compartment shall provide at least 1780 mm \pm 5mm **height** over the patient area, measured from floor to ceiling panels.

An **access window** between Driver's Cabin and Patient Compartment should be provided at appropriate location for visual checks and voice communication between the cabin and patient compartment. This window should be latch able from the patient cabin side and should be transparent, shatter proof and shall have adjustable opening.

Complete **interior panelling** of the sidewalls, partition between patient cabin and driver cabin, roof (of both patient and driver cabin) & back door panels should made from long life superior quality Fibre Reinforced Polymer (FRP).

The FRP wherever used, should have the following characteristics:

- Thickness minimum 3.0 mm for FRP.
- Inbuilt colour
- Fire retardant as per IS 6746 of 1988 or latest
- Should meet lamination standard IS 10192 or latest

There should be PUF / PU min. 12 mm thick or thermocol min. 45mm thick or equivalent insulation for reduction of heat and noise within the patient compartment. The insulating material should be non-toxic, non-settling type, vermin proof, mild dew proof and non hygroscopic.

Provision should be made for placement of power switches / sockets/ manifold outlets/ major medical equipment, with sufficient reinforcement for holding them securely while in transit.

Adequate provision for storage of medicines/consumables/equipment should be made by providing lockable **cabinets & drawers**. These should be made of fire retardant material, in sync with the ambulance's internal look and feel. The drawers should be on steel guide ways (of reputed brands only) & provided with ball socket locks to arrest the drawers opening during motion of ambulance.

The **floor** should be fitted with minimum 3.125 mm aluminium cladded chequered sheet or fire retardant 12 mm high density marine plywood with 2mm thick Anti-skid PVC vinyl matting or FRP with Anti-skid coating. If floor is appreciated marine plywood, suitable size of S.S sheet to be provided in rear side (stretcher loading area) to prevent scratches with flat head screw upto the stretcher wheel travel area.

The **footsteps** should be provided appropriately in the rear for easy entry/exit to the vehicle with sufficient reinforcement at both ends.

2 windows to be provided, one in each in side, at suitable height from ground for patient privacy.

The complete interior should be edgeless and suitable for easy cleaning / scientific fumigation / treatment of disinfectants. The ambulance interiors should be designed with care to avoid injuries by fall of equipment or cylinder on persons inside the ambulance in case of turmoil due to bad road conditions.

The **rear loading door** for entry into Patient Compartment should be of appropriate size and the door opening should be side-ways (preferably 270 degrees opening). Each door should be hinged at least at two places and should have firm latching provision.

Ambulance should have cabinets for storing medical equipments, supplies, wash basin and dust bins alongside the partition wall. Storing cabins are to be made of renowned brand of suitable thickness ply wood with (BWR and fire proof) width size & depth of min. 600 mm and height 900 mm. approximately. The ply wood to be cladded with S.S.Sheet (mirror finished). All the hardware like rails, channels, slides, locks, catchers, hinges, handles should be of heavy duty and of reputed make. Wash basin should be of S.S. with water top and supplying water through motorized pump (12v DC power operated heavy duty) with foot operated control to pump the water from fresh water tank. Fresh water tank and drain water tank of S.S and capacity 18 liter approx. Two no portable- concealed dust bins with spring loaded lids for waste disposal to be provided preferably under the wash basin.

A suitable size of squad's bench to be provided in left side with outside openable top seat. It will be used for storage purpose of extrication tools. Suitable size of foam cushions to be provided for comfort.

A comfortable foldable seat for EMT to be provided of suitable size with Velcro belts to fold it up. It should have one waist seat belt and facing towards the rear of patient compartment.

External oxygen cylinder compartment and delivery system to be provided. A suitable trolley to be fabricated with bonnet type locking arrangement and lever to be provided in driver cabin for opening. It should be dust proof. Trolley should be designed to hold two D-type oxygen cylinder under medical cabinet, both the cylinders can be handled independently. High pressure fire proof tubing (280 bar/4060 PSI) with male & female bull nose brass connector at both ends to be provided for connecting cylinder to gas regulator inside the patient compartment. Gas regulator is to be two stage pressure gauge. 2 No. humidifier bottles and flow meters (0-15 lit per min.) to be provided. Four points of brass (3+1) 3/8" to be provided in complete one assembly. Oxygen door cylinder should not obstruct with the structural members. There should not be any electrical connection in near vicinity or inside the oxygen cylinder housing.

General

(i) All the Panels, Parts Mounted and Provision for Medical Equipments to be Mounted, Shall have 4 mm thick Mild Sheet (MS Fe 410) sheet reinforced behind the specified area.

(ii) Gap between the FRP sheet the vehicle body shell should stuffed with (45mm thick) sand witch of PU foam and thermocol sheets to reduce the heat transmission.

(iii) Provision for placement of power switches/sockets/fans/air conditioner, telemedicine and for upgrading other electrical items eg: solar panels.

(iv) Provision for I.V hooks and holders 2 no. should be made on the ceiling or right side of the ambulance compartment with provision for holding it tight.

(v) Adequate provision for safeguarding oxygen regulator on the right side panel at suitable height.

(vi) Adequate provision to securely hold spine board along RHS wall over wheel hump.

(vii) Six plug switch board with on/off switches of standard quality (230 V AC) to be made available on the RHS wall around Medical Equipment's console Area.

Head Racks: Head racks (FRP-3mm thick mm) of suitable size to be built above the squad bench integrated with roof. Inner surface of head racks to be based with soft heatlon sheet of 4mm thickness. Head racks should have suitable closures to cover the opening and easily opera table.

<u>GRAB-RAILS</u>:- A grab rails of S.S to be provided with the ceiling with proper support at 4 places, the dia of pipe should be 30 mm min.

Suitable provision should be made available for securing the spine board above the RHS wheel hump cover with velcro band, scoop stretcher by the side of squade bench, wheel chair to be placed suitably with velcro belts and fire extinguisher placed properly.

All the rear and side window should have non transparent white film pasted up to

a height which is 50 mm more them half of the height of window to avoid any

visibility into the ambulance.

Water Dispenser: - A water dispenser of 6 liter is to be provided with straps near wash basin area.

Air Conditioning system:-

- (i) It should be split A.C with suitable condenser and evaporator, and to be mounted on Roof and suitable for ambulance propose and driven by engine power.
- (ii) Its rated cooling capacity should not be less than 6.5 k.w. All units like blower, condenser cooling coil, expansion valve should be of reputed make. A warranty of three years should be there on each of these parts.
- (iii) It should be a Single/Double blower type.
- (iv) With 50mm ducts (ports), properly sealed for no air leakage, in two rows (four each row), on the ceiling of the patient cabin, with collapsible flaps to cover the ports.
- (v) Digital microprocessor based temperature controller should be provided with fully automatic PCB based power supply.
- (vi) A.C system shall be certified for passenger vehicle usage.
- (vii) Ambulance should be equipped with heating system for the patient compartment and hot air shouls come though louvers'.

Inverter:-

- (i) True sine wave inverter.
- (ii) The batteries placed inside the driver's cabin with provision to be charged from external AC power,
- (iii) The inverter should be of well known brands.
- (iv) Inverter capacity- 600 watts/800VA,
- (v) Input range- AC 130 v -270V/DC 9.5V-13.8V,

(vi) Frequency- 50 Hz,

(vii) Power Factor- 0.8

(viii) Output Voltage- 220(+/-)10% (regulated output from full charge battery voltage to low charged battery voltage)

(ix) Waveform- Single Pulse PWM

(x) Efficiency- 85%

(xi) Charger- heavy duty CC/CV type with current limit at 12A with wide input range (150V-270A)

(xii) Integrated AC/DC supply inside the vehicle synchronous with alternator.

Light bar:-

(i) Rhombic shaped, Double layered structure, Combination of continually lit, turning lamps, High quality tungsten bulbs and xenon lamp tube (e.g. GRAND/SHOLPHIN).

(ii) LED based configuration will be preferred.

(iii) Long life span, high luminance, Voltage: DC 12V, Power: 92W + 18W,

(iv) With integrated Public Addressing System of 100W (PMPO).

Flashers, Spot Light, Tube Light:-

Electrical Requirements

In ambulance, there should be two types of electrical design fitment and performance requirements.

1. Electrical power generated by the integrated alternator with engine. This alternator power generated should meet the requirement of automobile lighting, signalling, roof mounted bar, beacon lamps, visual and audible alarms, including HVAC requirements.

The alternator of the vehicle should be heavy duty to fulfil all required loads mentioned. Moreover, it should also provide additional 20 % (i.e. 120 %) of its full rated output, for continuous operation.

2. For auxiliary power requirements of the patient cabin – An inverter to be installed in a suitable place in the vehicle, which will fulfil the power requirements of medical equipments, interior illumination devices lamps, bulbs, tubes, entrance illumination, spot lights, etc.

Fuse and Other Safety Measures:.

(i) A separate fuse to each of the (as mentioned above) circuits be given.

(ii) There should be an indicator mark to each fuse on the fuse box be given to identify the fuse separately.

(iii) There should not be any joints be given within the circuits wiring.

(iv) At any unavoidable wiring junction(s) the wires should be joined through Bakelite connectors only.

(v) There should not be any loose wiring and loose joints.

(vi) Other than vehicle wiring harnesses, all wires/harness used for should be (Flexi cab, Finolex or equivalent make).

(vii) All the electrical accessories should carry ISI mark and be approved by technical committee and should be of (ARAI/ISI) automobile standard.

(viii) All other unspecified parts necessary for the wiring should be of Automobile grade and/ or ISI certified.

FM RADIO:-

One FM Radio of good quality/reputed brand is to be provided in the driver compartment with speakers.

CLOCK:-

A digital clock is to be provided in the patient compartment. It should have a minimum letter (font) Size of 50 to have better visibility.

DC Connections Socket:

Crabtree, 2 DC sockets 12V near Equipments area.

Roof/Wall mounted fans:-

- (i) Half safety metal guard, Screw mounting. Oscillating, 8 inches fan blade,
- 2- Speed switch, operated by DC 12V in 2 nos. in the Patient compartment.
- (ii) One fan (same as above) in Driver (Pilot) compartment.

Exhaust Fan:

To be mounted to patient between driver and ambulance compartment, to pump ambient air into the patient compartment. One 8 inches exhaust fan on patient wall.

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General:-

- **1.** Curtain rod and curtains:- Hospital curtains to cover door classes for patient privacy to be provided. Foldable sun wiser to be provided on the window between patient and pilot cabin.
- **2. Pilot cabin light:** Light should be provided in pilot cabin having luminosity good enough to enable pilot in reading and writing in the registers.
- **3.** External stickering as per the approved design by- Department of Medical, Health & Family Welfare Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- **4.** Velcrobe strips should be provided everywhere arresting the movement of any equipment/trays, curtains etc.
- 5. Name Tagging: Etched & color coded name tags should be provided on the medical drawers.
- 6. A white board of suitable size is to be provided and fixed for making notes with a marker pen.
- 7. Medical equipments as to be fitted in patient compartment at right side in such a way so they may not fall and convenient to use.

WORKMANSHIP CRITERA FOR ACCEPTANCE

General appearance of the vehicle shall not show any evidence of poor workmanship. The following shall be reason rejection:

- 1. Rough, sharp or unfinished edges, burrs, seam, sharp corners, joints, cracks, and dents.
- 2. Non-uniform panels. Edges that are not filleted, beveled, etc.
- 3. Paint runs sage, orange peel, "fish eyes", etc. and any other imperfection or lack of complete coverage.
- 4. Body panels that are uneven, unsealed, or have voids.
- 5. Misalignment of body fasteners, glass, viewing panels, light housings, other items with large or uneven gaps, spacing etc. such as door, body panels and hinged panels.
- 6. Improper body design or interface with the chassis that could cause injury during normal use or maintenance.
- 7. Improperly fabricated and routed wiring or harnesses.
- 8. Improperly supported or secured hoses, wires, wirings, wiring harnesses, mechanical controls.
- 9. Looses, vibrating, abrading body parts, components, subassemblies, hoses, wiring harnesses or trim.
- 10. Interference of chassis components, body parts, door, etc.
- 11. Leaks of any gas fluid lines, (AC, coolant, oil, oxygen, etc.)
- 12. To avoid noise, panel vibration, all panels and roof sheet metal has to be coated with anti druming compound
- 13. Sagging, non-form fitting upholstery or padding.
- 14. Incomplete or incorrect application of rust proofing.
- 15. Inappropriate or incorrect use of hardware, fasteners, components, or methods of construction. All fasteners used should be of 8.8 grade.
- 16. All metallic parts used in fabrication should be coated with apoxy (primer) e.g Asian paints, SD or equivalent.

The supplier shall supplies for the equipments, instruments and other supplies on the basis of the supply Orders placed to supplier from time to time by the procuring authorities specifying the quantities required to be supplied at the specific location in the state of Rajasthan.

#### 4. Now these Presents witness:

- (i) In Consideration of the payment to be made by the RMSC or consignee offices at the rates set forth in the schedule hereto a appended the approved supplier will duly supply the said articles set forth in Schedule of Rates and supply order thereof in the manner set forth in the conditions of the tender and also appended to this agreement will be deemed to be taken as part of this agreement and are binding on the parties executing this agreement.
- (iii) Letters received from Bidder and letters issued by RMSC in the regard of this tender and also as appended to this agreement shall also form part of this Agreement.
- (iii) (a) RMSC do hereby agree that if the approved supplier shall duly supply the said articles in the manner aforesaid observe and keep the said terms and conditions, RMSC will through Demand Draft/RTGS Transfer or cause to be paid to the approved supplier at the time and the manner set forth in the said conditions, the amount payable for each and every consignment.
  - (b) The mode of payment will be as specified in terms & conditions of the tender i.e. through RTGS/ banker's cheque/Demand Draft etc.
    - The delivery shall be effected and completed within the period noted below from the date of supply order:-

- 6. (i) The time specified for delivery in the tender form shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the successful Bidder shall arrange supplies within the period on receipt of order from the Purchase Officer.
  - (ii) In case extension in the delivery period with liquidated damages, the recovery shall be made on the basis of following percentages of value of stores which the Supplier has failed to supply :-
    - (a) Delay up to one fourth period of the prescribed delivery period 2.5 %
    - (b) Delay exceeding one fourth but not exceeding half of the 5% Prescribed delivery period.
    - (c) Delay exceeding half but not exceeding three fourth 7.5%of the prescribed delivery period.
    - (d) Delay exceeding three fourth of the prescribed delivery period. 10%
  - (iii) Fraction of a day in reckoning period of delay in supplies shall be eliminated if it is less than half a day.
  - (iv) The maximum amount of agreed liquidated damages shall be 10%.
  - (i) If the supplier requires an extension of time in completion of contractual supply on account of occurrence of any hindrances, he shall apply in writing to the authority which had placed the supply order, for the same immediately on occurrence of the hindrance but not after the stipulated date of completion of supply.
  - (ii) Delivery period may be extended with or without liquidated damages if the delay in the supply of goods is on account of hindrances beyond the control of the Supplier.

#### 7. **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT ON BREACH OF CONDITION**

 (i) (a) In case the Supplier fails or neglects or refuse to faithfully perform any of the Covenants on his part herein contained, it shall be lawful for the Purchaser to forfeit the amount deposited by the Supplier as Security Deposit and cancel the Contract.

(b) In case the Supplier fails, neglects, or refuse to observe, perform, fulfill and keep, all or any one or more or any part of any one of the Covenants, stipulation and provision herein contained, is shall be lawful for the Purchaser or any such failure, neglect or refusal, to put an end to this Agreement and thereupon every article, cause and thing herein contained on the part of the Purchaser shall cease and be void, and in case of any damage, loss, expenses, difference in cost or other moneys from out of any moneys for the time being payable to the Supplier under this and/or any other Contract and in case such last mentioned moneys are insufficient to cover all such damages, losses, expenses, difference in cost and other moneys as aforesaid, it shall be lawful for the Purchaser to appropriate the Security Deposit made by the Supplier as herein before mentioned to reimburse all such damages, losses, expenses, difference in cost and other money as the Purchaser shall have sustained, incurred or been put to by reason of the Supplier having been guilty of any such failure, negligence or refusal as aforesaid or other breach in performance of this Contract.

(c) If at any time during the course of the Contract, it is found that any information furnished by the Supplier to the Purchaser, either in his Tender or otherwise, is false, the Purchaser may put an end to the Contract/Agreement wholly or in part and thereupon the provision of Clause (a) above shall apply.

- 2. The Purchaser reserves the right to terminate without assigning any reasons therefore the Contract/Agreement either wholly or in part without any notice to the Supplier. The Supplier will not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever in respect of such termination of the Contract/Agreement by the Purchaser.
- 3. Notice Etc in writing All Certificates or Notice or orders for time or for extra, varied or altered supplies which are to be the subject of extra or varied charges whether so described in the Agreement or not, shall be in writing, and unless in writing, shall not be valid, binding or be of any effect whatsoever.
- 4. Suppliers not have any interest in the offices concerned and subordinates The Supplier shall not be in any way interested in or concerned directly or indirectly with, any of the Officers, Subordinate or Servants of the Purchaser. In any trade, business or transactions not shall the Supplier give or pay or promise to give or pay such Officer, Subordinate or Servant directly or indirectly any money or fee or other consideration under designation of "Custom" or otherwise; nor shall the Supplier permit any person or persons whomsoever to interfere in the management or performance hereof under power of attorney or otherwise without the consent in writing the consent in writing of the Purchaser obtained in first hand.
- 5. Bankruptcy of the Supplier In case the Supplier at any time during the continuance of the Contract becomes bankrupt or insolvent or commits any act of bankruptcy or insolvency under the provisions of any law in that behalf for the time being in force, or should compound with his creditors, it shall be lawful for the Purchaser to put an end to the Agreement, and thereupon every article, clause and thing herein contained to be operative on the part of the Purchaser, shall cease and be void and the Purchaser shall have all the rights and remedies given to him under the preceding clauses.
- 6. Serving of notice on Supplier All notice or communication relating to or arising out of this Agreement or any of the terms thereof shall be considered duly served on or given to the Supplier if delivered to him or left at his premises, place of business or abode.
- 7. Dispute Settlement All disputes arising out of this agreement and all questions relating to the Interpretation of this agreement shall be decided by the Managing Director, RMSC and the decision of the M.D. RMSC shall be final as per tender terms and conditions.

And it is hereby agreed and declared between the parties hereto that in case any question of dispute arises touching the construction or wording of any of clause herein contained on the rights, duties, liabilities of the parties hereto or any other way, touching or arising out of the presents, the decision of the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd in the matter shall be final and binding.

In case of Dispute of difference arising between the Purchaser and a Supplier relating to any matter arising out of or connected with this agreement, such disputes or difference shall be settled in accordance with Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral tribunal shall consist of 3 arbitrator one each to be appointed by the purchaser and the Supplier. The third Arbitrator shall be chosen by the two Arbitrators so appointed by the Parties and shall act as presiding arbitrator.

- 8. If the rates of the approved items are reduced in any manner by the G.O.I./other State Govts, the approved supplier will have to reduce the rates in the same Proportion.
- 9. The Firm Shall furnish consolidated statement of supplies made, in enclosed format to each consignee in Statement No I & in statement No II to ED(EPM), RMSC by the 10th of the month duly verified by the consignee (s) as per terms of conditions.

#### JURISDICTION: 10.

All actions, proceedings and suits arising from or connected to this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Jaipur.
