**CONDITIONS OF TENDER FOR EMPANELMENT OF APPROVED DRUG ANALYTICAL TESTING

ITEMS FOR RAJASTHAN MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED FOR A
PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE TENDER**

“CONFIDENTIALITY IS THE ESSENCE OF THIS TENDER”

1. Sealed tenders are invited for empanelment of approved Drug testing Laboratories (under Drugs & Cosmetics Act) which are GLP compliant (As per schedule L-1)/NABL accredited for drugs requiring chemical/physico- chemical, instrumental and microbiological Testing facilities. The tender is invited from the Approved Drug Testing Labs situated in the state of Gujarat, Rajasthan, M.P., Haryana, Maharastra, Himachal Pradesh and NCR of Delhi.
2. Sealed Tenders will be received till 1.30 PM on 26.04.2012 by the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Ltd, D-Block, Swasthya Bhawan, Tilak Marg, C-Scheme, Jaipur 302005. **Empanelment of Approved Drug Testing Laboratories for Analysis of Drugs, Surgicals and Sutures items for a period of One Year from the date of acceptance of the tender.** The tender may however be extended for a further period on mutually agreed terms.
3. **Eligibility Criteria for Empanelment :-**
 - (1) Drug Testing Laboratories should be having Approval under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, with three years standing in the analysis of drugs, Surgicals and sutures items.
 - (2) The laboratory should be GLP compliant under the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and rules their under and should hold schedule L-1 certificate or should have NABL accreditation with proper scope of accreditation to undertake testing of drugs, surgical and sutures.
 - (3) The laboratory should have an average annual turnover of **Rs. 50 Lakhs** for past preceding three years (2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11), however, the Government Laboratories, Research & Development Laboratories, Laboratories

run by Co-operative body & Educational Institutions are exempted from the turnover criteria and are eligible to participate in the tender.

(4) The lab should have undertaken test and analysis of drugs and supplies of similar nature of at least three government institutions/corporation/reputed manufacturers of drug formulations.

(5) The lab should not stand banned/debarred or blacklisted by any State or Central Government organizations or its procurement agencies on the due date of bid submission.

(6) The laboratory and its responsible persons should not have been convicted under the provisions of applicable laws with regard to the activities and conduct of the laboratory.

(7) The laboratory should have all necessary instruments/equipments/machines for testing of drugs with minimum three functional HPLC's.

4. The tender document can be downloaded from the RMSCL website www.rmssc.nic.in and tender fees of Rs.1000/- may be paid at the time of bid submission by demand draft.

5. The tenderer must submit the following documents in the sealed cover superscribed "Cover A".

a) The tenderer shall submit a checklist of the list of documents enclosed and their page Nos. (In the enclosed proforma in Annexure – VI).

b) The Earnest Money Deposit shall be Rs. 20,000/-. The Earnest Money Deposit shall be paid in the form of Demand Draft favouring Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, payable at Jaipur. The EMD should be sent with the tender form in Cover-A. EMD in the form of Cheque/Cash/Postal Order will not be accepted. The EMD will not earn interest.

c) Attested Photocopy of Analytical approval duly renewed up to date, issued by the State Licensing Authority.

d) Compliance of Schedule L-1 of Drugs & Cosmetics Rules, 1945 (GLP certificate)/Copy of NABL accreditation with scope for testing of drug formulations.

- e) Documentary evidence of having analysed Drugs /Surgical / Sutures for the last three years with a statement in the proforma as given in Annexure I.
- f) Attested copy of certificate of registration for service tax.
- g) Non Conviction Certificate by the State Licensing Authority.
- h) *Annual turnover statement for 3 year i.e, 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11 certified by the practicing Chartered Accountant.***
- i) *Copies of the Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account for three years i.e. 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11 duly certified by the practicing Chartered Accountant.***
- j) The following information in the form given in Annexure II (a) to II(c).**
 - a) The list of qualified personnel employed in the laboratory with proof of their qualifications and relevant approvals.
 - b) The list of sophisticated instruments available in the laboratory.
 - c) Micro Biological facilities available in the laboratory.
 - d) List of Reference Samples along with their date of procurement and quantities.
 - e) In the case of Non- Pharmacopoeial Products the Method of Analysis Should be Appended to the Report, especially if the sample is declared as “not of standard quality”.
 - f) A declaration in the proforma given in Annexure III duly signed and notarized.
 - g) Details of Laboratory in Annexure – IV.
 - h) The tenderer should sign at the bottom of all pages of the tender Document with official seal and enclose it in **cover “A”**.

Cover B:

6. (a) Annexure – V (Price Bid) of Tender duly filled in giving the rate of Testing charges for complete analysis of each sample and signed on each page with official seal of the tenderer affixed, should be sent in a separate sealed cover, superscribing “**Cover B**” hereafter called “**Cover B**”. (Annexure VII of the tender document to be used for quoting the rate of testing charges).
(b) Cover B shall consists of the rates only, quoted by the tenderer. It shall not consist of any other documents.
7. The tender documents, certificates EXCEPT ANNEXURE VII (PRICE BID) must be submitted in a separate sealed cover COVER “A” and ANNEXURE VII (PRICE BID) of the tender document shall be kept in a separate sealed COVER “B”. Both cover “A” and cover “B” kept in a separate cover and on which it shall be superscribed a “TENDER FOR EMPANELMENT OF APPROVED DRUG TESTING LABORATORIES FOR THE TEST AND ANALYSIS OF SAMPLES OF DRUGS, SURGICALS AND SUTURE ITEMS” FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE **DUE ON 26.04.2012 Upto 1.30 P.M .”**
b) The tender document should reach the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited on or before **1.30 P.M on 26.04.2012.**

GENERAL CONDITIONS

8. The details of the Drugs, Surgical and Sutures to be analysed shall be given in Annexure V.
9. Forms in all annexure where ever to be filled should be filled up by typewritten and every correction should invariably be attested with full signature by the tenderer with date, failing which the tender will be summarily rejected. However no correction in the price bid will be considered.
10. The tenderer should quote the rates for complete analysis of each product and not for individual test to be performed. Product wise name and number of test to be performed, methodology to be used for each test should be mentioned.
11. The rates quoted should be exclusive of taxes, if any, and other statutory charges.

12. The tenders will remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of Technical bid.
13. Rates should be specific and should be furnished both in figures and words. In case of discrepancy between figures and words, the rates quoted in words will be taken.
14. The rates quoted and accepted will be binding on the tenderer for the stipulated period and on no account any revision will be entertained till the completion of the tender period.
15. Analytical Laboratory, which also has its manufacturing activity, if empanelled by RMSCL, then Samples of its own manufacturing unit shall not be sent to its empanelled laboratory for testing.
16. The laboratory will not be permitted to outsource any test from other laboratory.
17. RMSCL shall have the right to cause the laboratory to be inspected by the members of its technical committee before opening of price bid and subsequently as and when considered appropriate and based on the finding, the tenderer may be disqualified or de-empanelled, as the case may be.

ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER

18. Out of the two covers submitted by each tenderer, Cover “A” will be opened first, **at the office of RMSCL, RHSDP Block, Swasthya Bhawan, Tilak Marg, C-Scheme, Jaipur 302005.** at 2.30 P.M. on **26.04.20112** in the presence of Tenderers / Authorised persons of the tenderers who choose to be present. After scrutiny of the documents and the information furnished in Cover “A” and confirmation of details stated therein, a list of eligible laboratories will be shortlisted.
19. There after the tenderers found eligible as stated above on the basis of the examination on Cover “A”. The Cover “B” will be opened and after scrutiny thereof, including inspection of the laboratory, if required, the acceptable rates for analysis will be decided and communicated.
20. The Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited reserves the right to accept or reject any tender for any one or more of the items tendered for, without assigning any reason.

AGREEMENT

21. The agreement with empanelled laboratories will remain valid for a period of one year from the date of signing of agreement. This may be further extended for a further period of six months with mutual consent.
22. All tenderers who are empanelled will have to execute an agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper of value **Rs. 1000** /- (Stamp duty to be paid by the tenderer), in favour of Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited Jaipur within 15 days from the date of receipt of the intimation to them informing that their tenders have been accepted. The form of agreement will be issued by RMSCL.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

23. The successful tenderers shall be required to pay a security deposit of **Rs.50,000/-** *in the form of demand draft* at the time of execution of the agreement.

COMPLETE ANALYSIS & REPORTING CONDITIONS

24. (a) On empanelment and entrustment of the job, the Analytical Laboratory should furnish the test reports within.
 - I. **10 days from the receipt of the sample in case of Tablets, Capsules, Pessaries, Ointments, Powder and Liquid Oral Preparations**
 - II. **21 days from the receipt of the sample in the case of I.V. Fluids and injectables and other items requiring test for sterility.**
- b) All the tests mentioned in IP/BP/USP/Drugs & Cosmetics Act. etc., (as the case may be) should be carried out for each and every sample. The results obtained in the test should be mentioned in numerical value (wherever possible). However this condition will not apply when only specific testing is called for/desired on any particular sample.
- c) **“COMPLIES” or “PASSES” in the result column of the report is treated as incomplete report, if the result has some numerical value.**

- d) **Every test report must have remarks either as “Standard Quality” or “Not of Standard Quality”. Any ambiguity/cutting will not be accepted (mention of “standard quality/not of standard quality” and crossing/cutting one of these will not be accepted).**
- e) Reports should be in A4 size (8.27” X 11.69”) paper of good quality
- f) Reports should have Sl.No. Description of tests, Specifications & Results obtained and should be signed by authorized approved Technical Person.
- g) Reports should be attached along with Spectra / Chromatography data sheets if applicable and it will be considered incomplete if spectra or chromatograms are not attached
25. All test reports should be submitted to the RMSC in triplicate. In case of failure of a sample, the result should be communicated immediately to the Executive Director (Q.C.) through phone / Fax / E-mail and the report should be sent with protocol.
26. If in any circumstances (like break down of instrument, non availability of reference standard etc.) the Analytical Laboratory is unable to undertake analysis for a sample, the same should be reported within 24 hours of receipt of such a sample by FAX or E-mail and the sample should be returned to the Executive Director (Quality Control), Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, Jaipur. In case of inability of laboratory to undertake the testing, a penalty of 25% of testing charges applicable for that product/products will be recovered. If placebo or standard test procedure of any product is required the same should be demanded within 48 hours with return request. Period lapsed/taken in providing placebo or standard testing procedure will be condoned from prescribed time limit for that sample.
27. If any sample is received in a damaged condition by the laboratory, the sample should not be analyzed and the information should be sent immediately to the E.D. (Quality Control), Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited Jaipur by FAX or E-mail.
28. The Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited or his authorised representative(s) has / have the right to inspect the laboratories of the tenderers who have submitted tenders, before taking any decision

regarding empanelment. Similarly, the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited or his authorised representatives may also inspect any empanelled laboratory, at any point of time during the continuance of the tender and terminate / cancel its empanelment or any orders issued to the laboratory, not to entrust any further testing job to the laboratory based on facts brought out during such inspections.

PAYMENT PROVISIONS

29. No advance payment towards any analysis will be made to the empanelled tenderer.
30. No payment will be made for the incomplete analysis or incomplete report. Deliberate omission of any critical test will be viewed seriously and shall invite action against the laboratory as deemed fit by RMSCL.
31. Payments towards the analysis of Drugs, Surgicals and Sutures will be made along with Tax at the prevailing rate as applicable at the time of payment.

PENALTIES

32. If the successful tenderer fails to execute the agreement and payment of security deposit within the time specified or withdraws the tender after intimation of the acceptance of the tender has been sent to or owing to any other reasons, he is unable to undertake the contract, the empanelment will be cancelled and the Earnest Money Deposit deposited by the tenderer shall stand forfeited in favour of the Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited. Such tenderer(s) will also be liable for all damages sustained by the Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited due to of breach of tender conditions. Such damages shall be assessed by the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited whose decision shall be final.
33. Non performance of any tender or empanelment conditions will disqualify a laboratory to participate in the tender for the period as decided by RMSCL.

34. If it is revealed that the analytical Laboratory is involved in any form of fraud and collusion with the suppliers of Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited, the Analytical Laboratory will be black listed for a period considered suitable. The tenderers shall also be liable for action under criminal law and the matter will be notified to the concerned Director of Drugs Control for suitable action against them under Drugs & Cosmetics Act & Rules.
35. The Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited will be at liberty to terminate without assigning any reasons, the empanelment of any laboratory either wholly or in part at one month's notice. The tenderer will not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever in respect of such termination.
36. In all matters pertaining to the tender, the decision of the Managing Director, Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited shall be final and binding.
37. (i) If the laboratory requires an extension in time for submission of test report, on account of occurrence of any hindrance he shall apply in writing for extension on occurrence of hindrance but not after the stipulated date of *furnishing the test report*.
- (ii) The Executive Director (QC)/ General Manager (QC) may extend the testing period with or without liquidated damages in case they are satisfied that the delay in the submission of test reports is on account of any hindrances, he shall apply in writing for extension on occurrence of hindrance but not after the stipulated date of submission of report. Reasons shall be recorded.
- (iii) **Extension in testing period:-** In case of extension in the testing period with liquidated damages the recovery shall be made on the basis of following percentages of *testing charges* which the tenderer has failed to submit:-
- (a) Delay upto one fourth period of the prescribed testing period; 2.5%
- (b) Delay exceeding one fourth but not exceeding half of the prescribed testing period; 5%

(c) Delay exceeding half but not exceeding three fourth of the prescribed testing period; 7.5%

(d) Delay exceeding three fourth of the prescribed testing period; 10%

Note: Fraction of a day in reckoning period of delay in *furnish the test report* shall be eliminated if it is less than half a day. The maximum amount of liquidated damages shall be 10%.

(iv) If, at any time during the continuance of this Agreement, the *laboratory* has, in the opinion of the Purchaser, delayed in submitting any test report, by the reasons of any riots, mutinies, wars, fire, storm, earthquakes, tempest or other exceptional cause, on a specific request made by the laboratory, the time for submitting test report may be extended by the *RMSCL* surely at his discretion for such period as may be considered reasonable. No further representation from the *laboratory* will be entertained on this account.

JURISDICTION

38. In the event of any legal dispute arising out of the tender such dispute would be subject to the jurisdiction of the Civil courts within the city of Jaipur.
