We have heard the Learned Counsels for the parties and also perused the report submitted by Learned Commissioner on 15-09-2018. In the said report it has been clearly indicated as to the steps which have been taken by the steel industries which had been permitted to operate. However, the Commissioner has pointed out certain deficiencies which still remain.

We consider it just and proper to accept the prayer made by the counsels for the industries to grant further time of one week to the steel industries to rectify the deficiencies. It may be known by the industries that in respect of rectifying the remaining deficiencies, a surprise inspection would be conducted by the Commissioner. The remuneration and other expenses of the Commissioner of such inspection shall be paid by the industries which may share by them.

We have considered the applications filed by textile industries according to which they are said to have removed the deficiencies as pointed out by the Commissioner in his first report dated 15-05-2018.

Based on the submission made by the Learned Counsels for Textile Industries, we deem it proper to permit the following Textile industries may function: (1) M/s. A. K. International, (2) M/s. Surendra Impex (3) M/s. V. N. Exports, (4) M/s Sarvotam Prints (5) M/s. S. Kumar Industries, (6) Rajasthan Battery Plates (7) M/s. Sorabh Textile, (8)M.s/ Rishabh Creations, (9)M/s. Vertex Industries, (10)M/s. Rama Global, (11)M/s. Osian Impex, (12) M/s. Mohan Lal Textile and (13) M/s. Lakshya Prints Textile, subject to the conditions that a surprise inspection would be conducted by the Commissioner and
