<u>Instructions for candidates for viewing Question paper, responses,</u> <u>answer key and raising objection online in this regard</u>

- 1. To view the Question paper, responses, answer key and raising objection, the candidates should go to the online link available on the Board's website. For raising objection pay the fee of Rs. 100/- per question for the questions to which objections are to be made, through their login ID and password. Objections will not be accepted in the absence of fee.
- 2. The link will be available only from **Date 11-02-2025 to Date 20-02-2025**, after which the link will be deactivated.
- 3. The candidate can look at the Question Id from the QPHTML available beside the "Candidate Response" tab. Candidate should ensure that the Question Id is as per the QHTML only.
- 4. After the candidate have filled all the required fields such as Question Id, (s)he should click on "Submit" button to submit the objection successfully.
- 5. Uploading of Proof/evidence in support of objection raised mandatory. If proof not attached, objection will not be considered.
- 6. Attach only the proofs of the Standard/Authentic books. Write your roll number and the Question ID of the relevant question on each page of such proof and then upload it. It is necessary to write the name of the book, author/authors' names, publisher's name, edition year and page number in the reference. In case the desired proof is not attached, the objections will not be considered.
- 7. Objections once submitted cannot be edited later.
- 8. Only one objection can be raised at a time.
- 9. <u>If any candidate while raising objection, uploads the proof which has been</u> <u>tampered/forged/fabricated from the original text, the State Board has</u> <u>liberty to initiate appropriate action against such candidate and criminal</u> <u>complaint will be lodged.</u>
