## SPECIAL DISPENSATION SCHEME- REGARDING

As per the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution), Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, all industries/ processes/ projects/ activities etc. shall obtain prior Consent to Establish and Operate before establishing/ operating any industry/ process/ activity etc. However, there is possibility of some of the industry process/ activity etc. are operating without valid Consent to Operate from the State Board.


In an attempt to give an opportunity to such non-compliant units to operate in regulated manner under the provisions of the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 the State Board had in past introduced 'Special dispensation schemes' vide office order nos. F12(56-B)/Policy/Plg/RPCB/6024-55, 1415-48, 1162-1208, 584-628, 987- 1021,195-229, 1263 – 1296, 2276 – 2279, 1687 – 1697 & 2172 – 2179 dated 22.02.2012, 30.08.2013, 08.03.2018, 14.09.2018, 01.02.2021, 01.07.2021, 03.11.2023, 27.11.2024 & 14.02.2025.

In continuation to the effort and to encourage Textile sector units operating without CTO to apply for consent, the State Board has decided to bring in a "Special Dispensation scheme" whereby such units can apply for CTE/CTO till 31/03/2026. The applications will be subjected to following conditions:

- i. This scheme will be applicable for Textile sector units which are not presently under the ambit of consent management of the State Board.
- ii. Such industries will apply for Consent to Establish as well as Consent to Operate under the provisions of the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 as per the prevailing procedure/ fee. However, as one-time relaxation, such units will not be required to pay the back-period fees for the years, they have been in operation without valid consent.
- iii. The scheme will also be applicable on Textile sector units which have already applied for consent and their applications are pending with the State Board. (irrespective of date of application).

All Group In-charges and Regional Officers are directed to ensure disposal of all consent applications received under this scheme on priority. In any case all such consent applications shall be disposed within 60 days from the receipt of the application in the Board.


